WHEREAS, the Township of West Orange (the "Township") has established an Employee Assistance Program ("EAP") through the State of New Jersey, Civil Service Commission, Employee Advisory Service ("EAS"); and

WHEREAS, the Township wishes to continue the EAP for the 2017 Fiscal Year, which begins on July 1, 2016 and concludes on June 30, 2017, for the purpose of providing Township employees with counseling services to enhance morale and performance ("EAS Services"); and

WHEREAS, the Civil Service Commission offers EAS Services on a "per employee" basis, whereby the Township would be charged \$10 per Township employee, or on a "per session" basis, whereby the Township would be charged \$125 per session for any sessions with Township employees lasting more than 20 minutes, and \$250 per session for all other workshops or emergency response services; and

WHEREAS, the Township has determined, based upon past rates of participation by Township employees, that obtaining the EAS Services on a "per session" basis would be the more cost-efficient option;

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that the Township Council authorizes the Mayor to execute an agreement with the EAS (annexed hereto as Exhibit "A") to provide EAS Services for the 2017 Fiscal Year on a "per session" basis, whereby the Township will be charged \$125. per session who participates in the program; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution and supporting documentation remain on file with the Municipal Clerk for inspection by the public.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Township Council be Resolution No. 89-16 dated March 22, 2016 awarded the contract Street Improvements 2016 in the amount of \$3,355,203.44 to Reggio Construction, Inc., 1575 West Street, Fort Lee, New Jersey 07024; and

WHEREAS, this contract included improvements to 25 street totaling about 4.51 miles in length; and

WHEREAS, one of the 25 streets included Dawes Avenue; and

WHEREAS, Dawes Avenue is accessed from "Old" Pleasant Valley Way which is a former Essex County roadway that was relocated during the construction of Interstate Route 280 in the late 1960's and early 1970's; and

WHEREAS, Old Pleasant Valley Way is used to access local Municipal streets as well as several homes which front it; and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Engineer advised the Township Council of the need to improve "Old" Pleasant Valley Way from Dawes Avenue to just north of Lincoln Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Engineer recommends Change Order No. 1 be approved with Reggio Construction Inc. to improve "Old" Pleasant Valley Way and take advantage of the economies of scale that will accrue while improving this street in conjunction with the improvement of Dawes Avenue under the 2016 contract prices; and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost to improve "Old" Pleasant Valley Way which is approximately 750 feet long under Change Order No. 1 to the contract Street Improvements 2016 is \$75,000; and

WHEREAS, Change Order No. 1 amounts to a 2.23 percent increase in the original project amount; and

WHEREAS, sufficient funds exist for the additional work under Change Order No. 1; and

WHEREAS, the Township Council concurs in the foregoing.

**BOND ORDINANCE AMENDING BOND ORDINANCE
NUMBER 2475-16 FINALLY ADOPTED BY THE
TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WEST
ORANGE, NEW JERSEY ON FEBRUARY 9, 2016**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WEST ORANGE, IN THE COUNTY OF UNION, NEW JERSEY (not less than two-thirds of all the members thereof affirmatively concurring), AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Bond Ordinance of the Township Council of the Township of West Orange, in the County of Union, New Jersey (the "Township") entitled "Bond Ordinance Authorizing Various Capital Improvements In And For The Township Of West Orange, In The County Of Essex, New Jersey, Appropriating \$7,378,635 Therefore And Authorizing The Issuance Of \$7,027,266 Bonds Or Notes To Finance Part Of The Cost Thereof" finally adopted on February 9, 2016 (the "Ordinance") is hereby incorporated by reference in its entirety.

Section 2. Section 3(a)(ii) of the Ordinance is hereby amended in its entirety and is amended by inserting Section 3(a)(vi) as follows:

The Ordinance is further amended by deleting the reference of 14.33 years for the useful life and substituting in lieu therefor 12.55 years.

Section 3. The capital budget of the Township is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. The resolutions in the form promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services is on file with the Clerk and is available there for public inspection.

Section 4. This Section 4 constitutes a declaration of official intent under Treasury Regulation Section 1.150-2. The Township reasonably expects to pay expenditures with respect to the Improvements prior to the date that the Township incurs debt obligations under this Bond

Ordinance. The Township reasonably expects to reimburse such expenditures with the proceeds of debt to be incurred by the Township under this Bond Ordinance. The maximum principal amount of debt expected to be issued for payment of the costs of the Improvements is \$7,027,266.

Section 5. All other provisions of the Ordinance shall remain unchanged.

Section 6. This amendatory bond ordinance shall take effect twenty days after the first publication thereof after final adoption as provided by Local Bond Law.

CHAPTER 7, TRAFFIC, SUBSECTION 7-14.3, PARKING TIME LIMITED ON CERTAIN STREETS DURING
CERTAIN HOURS OF CERTAIN DAYS, 7-26.1, BUS STOPS (AT VARIOUS SCHOOL LOCATIONS)
AND SUBSECTION 7-14.9, PARKING PROHIBITED ADJACENT TO SCHOOLS
OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF
THE TOWNSHIP OF WEST ORANGE**

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Council of the Township of West Orange, in the County of Essex, State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1. Subsection 7-14.3, Parking Time Limited on Certain Streets During Certain Hours of Certain Days, of the Revised General Ordinances of the Township of West Orange is hereby supplemented and amended as follows (*italic type denotes deletion, bold type denotes addition*):

LEGISLATIVE HISTORY

With the completion of a School Bus Driveway in front of the Gregory School on Gregory Avenue, the bus stop for School Buses along Lowell Avenue location behind the School is no longer needed. The Ordinance eliminates the bus stop on Lowell Avenue. All of the easterly curbline of Lowell Avenue between Walker Road and Winding Way will be used as a student drop off and pick up area. This Ordinance rescinds the three (3) minute time limited parking that existed on the easterly curbline of Lowell Avenue located between Walker Road and Winding Way outside the bus stop area. The new regulation prohibits parking along the easterly curbline in this block on School Days between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. This regulation allows parent and guardians to discharge or pick up students there. 5
