

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 7, TRAFFIC, SUBSECTION 7-29.1, SPEED LIMITS IN GENERAL, OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WEST ORANGE

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Council of the Township of West Orange, in the County of Essex, State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1. Subsection 7-29.1, Speed Limits in General, of the Revised General Ordinances of the Township of West Orange is hereby supplemented and amended as follows (*italic type denotes deletion, bold type denotes addition*):

Name of Street	Direction	Speed Limit	Location
Lowell Avenue	Northbound	25 MPH	25 MPH Statutory Speed Limit from Walker Road to Winding Way except for a school speed limit of 15 MPH while children are going to and from school during opening and closing hours.

Section 2. If any provisions of this Ordinance or application thereof, under any circumstances, is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect any other provisions or applications of this Ordinance that can be given effect without the invalid provision(s) or application(s) and to this end the provisions of this Ordinance are severable.

Section 3. All other Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication in accordance with law.

LEGISLATIVE HISTORY

This Ordinance establishes a School Speed Limit of 15 MPH on Lowell Avenue between Walker Road and Winding Way adjacent to the Gregory Elementary School. This School Speed Limit will be effective while children are going to and from school during opening and closing hours. The Speed Limit at other times is established by State Statute and it is 25 MPH. The lower speed limit is necessary due to the use of Lowell Avenue for student discharge and pick-up.
