This ordinance is drafted to revise the municipal code provisions governing the towing of vehicles by licensed tow companies. The Municipal Code previously prohibited towing companies from charging towing and storage fees for vehicles towed as part of a criminal investigation, this ordinance would limit that prohibition to vehicles registered to Township residents.
