After Enrollment/During Home Visit

A Certified Building Performance Institute Contractor will reach out to set up a home visit

During the home visit:

- The contractor will go over the Comfort Partners Program
- Conduct a home energy audit
- Including safety and efficiency tests
- Discuss how your home uses energy
- Discuss how the program can help you

At the End of the Home Visit

The contractor will develop an action plan for your home



AND

Fill out a partnership agreement with you

After the Home Visit

- -Develop a scope of work
- -Return to your home
- -Install energy saving measures





What gets installed?

Cost effective energy efficiency measures may include:

- Energy efficient lighting
- Water heaters
- Refrigerators
- Energy saving thermostats
- Insulation, air sealing, duct sealing and repair
- And more!



Energy Saving Tips

- Drafts can cause you to lose heat in your home through leaky windows, doors, electrical outlets, light switches and other openings like your fireplace damper. Reducing air leaks could cut 10 percent from an average home energy bill
- When you are asleep or out of the house, turn your thermostat back 10 to 15 degrees for eight hours and save around 10% a year on your energy bills.
- Turn it off: Don't leave the video game on pause, the computer in sleep mode or the cell phone charger plugged in when you are done with it.
 Those electronics are still using energy, even when you are not using them.
