

COVID-19 IMPORTANT INFORMATION

TOWNSHIP OFFICES CLOSED TO PUBLIC – SERVICES TO CONTINUE

All Township of West Orange Municipal buildings will be closed to the public effective immediately until further notice.

- Township Departments will remain staffed to ensure the continued delivery of essential services. Staff will remain available through phone and email, although there may be delay in response due to staffing and schedule modifications. [Click here](#) for Township Department Directory.
- Most Township Services are available online, by phone or mail, with the exceptions of notary services, resident ID cards, and animal adoption days. These services are suspended until further notice.
- The Township is unable to accept cash for any transactions including, taxes, sewer fees, permits, etc. Payment may be made online, over the phone, check by mail or left in the locked drop box at the rear of Town Hall.
- Residents wishing to deliver documents, applications, etc. may do so utilizing the drop box or mail slot at each location.
- The Township's Health Department will be fully staffed and closely monitoring any local cases or situations as well as keeping informed and notifying our community about the most current information, restrictions, guidelines and recommendations from Federal, State, County and international officials and agencies.
- Police, Fire and EMS emergency services will continue uninterrupted and 9-1-1 emergency lines will be available and answered at all times.
- Garbage and Recycling services are provided through contracts with private companies. At present the Township has not been notified of any changes to regular services and schedules. Any changes to services will be posted on the Township website and disseminated via the Township's Swift911 emergency notification system.
