- Left Turns from South Grove Street onto Winthrop Terrace lot will not be permitted.
- Drivers should remain in their cars with the windows rolled up.
- A walk-up distribution will be held at the church entrance on Winthrop Terrace. Residents should line up along Winthrop coming from South Grove Street.
- Food boxes weigh about 35 pounds; walk ups encouraged to bring their own cart.
- Residents walking to the site are **REQUIRED** to wear face coverings and practice social distancing. Anyone not wearing a mask will not be allowed to enter the site.
- No arrivals before 8 a.m.
- **1,000 boxes to be distributed on a first-come, first-served basis.**
