

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, on July 13, 2021, the Township Council for the Township of West Orange (the “Township”) adopted resolution 188-21 authorizing the establishment of a Taskforce and Advisory Committee regarding Cannabis Businesses for the Township (the “Taskforce”); and

WHEREAS, the Taskforce was established as an effort to foster and provide a means of participation from residents in implementation of both the zoning and local licensing framework established in the Township’s Ordinance governing Cannabis businesses within the Township; and

WHEREAS, the Taskforce was framed to include seven (7) members including: (i) the Police Chief for the West Orange Police Department; (ii) a member of the Township Council designated as the Chair of the Taskforce; (iii) a second member of the Township Council; (iv) a resident serving on the Township’s Economic Development Commission; (v) a resident serving on the West Orange Planning Board or the West Orange Zoning Board of Adjustment; (vi) a resident serving on the Downtown West Orange Alliance; and (vii) a resident selected by the Mayor of the Township; and

NOW, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, by the Township Council of the Township of West Orange that the Township hereby authorizes and affirms the appointments to the Taskforce as follows:

- (i) Police Chief James P. Abbott;
- (ii) Council President Cindy Matute-Brown, Taskforce Chair;
- (iii) Councilwoman Michelle Casalino, Township Council;
- (iv) John Wayman Henry, III, West Orange Economic Development Commission;


- (v) Jonathan Redwine, West Orange Zoning Board of Adjustment;
- (vi) Abdur Yasin, Downtown West Orange Alliance; and
- (vii) Abdur Moore, Township Mayor's Appointment

(collectively the "Appointees") and it is further

RESOLVED that the Appointees shall serve for a term to expire on December 31, 2022 consistent with Resolution 188-21.
